

Desjardins scholarship - immigrant investor category Bachelor's degree, master's degree, doctoral degree

Number of scholarships and amounts (Limit of 1 scholarship per level per student)

Doctorate: One \$10,000 scholarship
Master's: One \$7,500 scholarship
Bachelor's: Five \$1,250 scholarships

Eligibility

This scholarship is exclusive to the families of immigrant investors having concluded a transaction with Desjardins Trust. Scholarships are awarded to candidates pursuing a degree in a recognized institution in Québec. Note that a student is entitled to a maximum of one scholarship per university level.

You must:

- Reside in the Province of Québec as an immigrant investor or as the spouse or child of an immigrant investor
- Be a full-time student of a Québec university at the Bachelor's, Master's or Doctorate degree level
- Reside in Canada for less than five years and have permanent resident status when applying for the scholarship
- Have an account with a Desjardins branch

How to apply?

- Fill out the attached application form and submit 2 copies
- Provide a photocopy of your PR card or proof of citizenship
- Send all your university transcripts
→ If you are a first year student provide a letter of acceptance or proof of registration
- A cheque specimen of your account with a Desjardins branch

Applications that do not meet these criteria will not be considered.
